WESTSIDE WOLVES HOCKEY CLUB *SENIOR MEMBERS' CODE OF CONDUCT*



1. Learn the rules of hockey and play by them.
2. Never argue with an umpire or official. If you have a problem, discuss it with your coach, manager or captain and allow him/her to take the necessary action.
3. Control your temper. Verbal abuse of, or deliberate physical interference and aggression with opponents will not be tolerated.
4. Respect the time and effort put in by your coaches and officials. They deserve your support and full commitment.
5. Accept that when more than eleven players are named for your match that you may be required to spend time off the field as a substitute. When not on the field encourage your team and be prepared to play at all times.
6. Respect the equipment provided for your use. Hockey equipment is very expensive and should be used responsibly.
7. Always act responsibly and avoid injury to yourself and others.
8. 100% attendance is required at both training and games. It is your responsibility to inform your coach or manager if you are not available for either. Remember, attendance at training may be a prerequisite for team selection.
9. It is expected that you will always be on time for training. You are also required to be at the game at least 30 minutes before the scheduled starting time to allow time to prepare for the game.
10. Wearing of correct uniform, at all times, is essential. According to the rules of the game you may not be permitted to take the field if incorrectly attired.
11. It is your responsibility to undertake your umpiring duties when rostered. Failure to do so will result in a fine and possible disciplinary action. Rule books and assistance will be available on request.
12. It is your responsibility to find out when and where you are playing each week. If necessary, contact your Club Playing Captain.
13. As a member of the Club you are required to fully participate in all fundraising activities.
14. You are encouraged to support your Club by watching other teams before and after your game and returning to the clubrooms after Saturday matches.
15. Attendance at Wizard Cup and Wizard League games is encouraged so that you can improve your hockey by learning from the best.
16. When representing your Club you must do so in such a way as not to bring the Club into disrepute. This includes your behavior at any Club function, particularly when exposed to public scrutiny.
17. Any problems regarding selections or playing should be referred, in the first instance, to your Team Captain and then your Playing Captain. Any other problems should be discussed with the appropriate Club Director/Vice President.
18. **Each player has umpiring obligations. You must fulfill this duty or find a replacement. Failure to do so will result in a \$100 penalty payable by the player.**
